The WCRA has grown quickly in Squamish, as it develops its West Coast Railway Heritage Park attraction. With the addition of railway and shop operations, as well as the current construction of the new Roundhouse & Conference Centre, Squamish is becoming a key hub for the Association's activities.

Susan comes to WCRA from the Okanagan, where she was most recently CEO of United Way in that area. She brings more than 20 years of leadership experience in the nonprofit sector, including past history with WCRA, having been the Association's first Executive Director during much of the 1990's. "We welcome Susan to the WCRA Leadership Team", says WCRA's President & CEO Don Evans, "and look forward to the addition of her leadership skills and active community participation to our growing team".

The West Coast Railway Heritage Park is home to Western Canada's largest heritage railway collection, including the world famous Royal Hudson steam locomotive. The 12-acre destination attraction is open year round, and hosts 40,000 guest visits annually. A new Roundhouse and Conference Centre is currently under construction as the third phase of development at the Squamish site, scheduled to open in 2009.
